"My friend Greg is very GREGarious - he's the life of the party!"

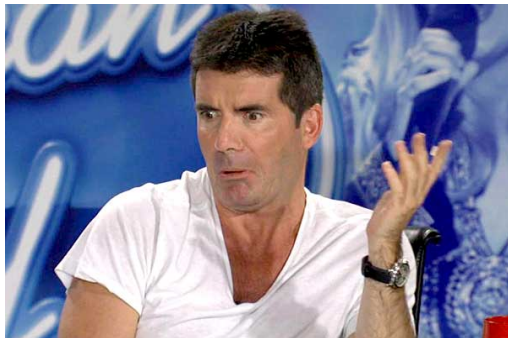


Gregarious Greg was friendly and outgoing to anyone who would share his company.

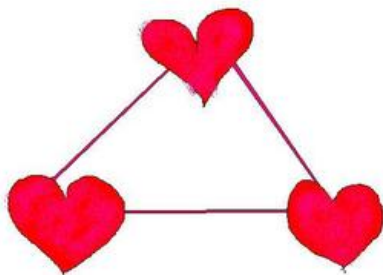
**23. Copious** - adjective - abundant, extensive
