## Apparitions:

① helmeted head → "Beware Macduff"

↓  
Thx for warning - confirmed my fear

② Bloody Child → be bold + firm  
"none of woman born shall harm Macb"

Macb → then I don't need to kill Macduff  
but I will to be 2x safe

③ child crowned w/ tree in hand -  
- Macbeth will not be conquered  
until Birnam Wood moved to  
Dunsinane Hill

Macb → freat! No one can move a forest!

Macbeth: Will Banquo's sons reign  
tell me or I'll curse you!  
Witches - no more info.

④ 8 Kings that look like Banquo  
↳ confirms original prophecy

Macbeth - plans to kill  
Macduff's wife + kids

## Act IV, sc. 2

### Lady Macduff -

upset that husband  
left - says he's a traitor

- "He loves us not."

- says he left out of fear

Ross - says he's noble

Murderers kill Lady, kids, & everyone  
in their path → Macbeth  
just continuing murderous  
rampage

Act 4, sc. 3 ~~Act 4~~

Malcolm + Macduff

- ↓
- distrust Macduff
  - questions why he left family if so unsafe
  - he was so close w/ Macbeth - why should he trust them
- Scotland is in despair; dire condition
  - giving up hope

Malcolm tests Macduff Macd.

- says he's lustful → plenty of women
- says he's greedy → plenty to go around; your virtue outweighs
- has no virtues → then Scotland is doomed - I'll

Malcolm

- J/K - I'm honorable (sincerity + true motivation is confirmed)
- is gathering 10k men w/ Siward
- getting ready to hack Macbeth

Act 4, scene 3

Malcolm + Macduff

- suspicious of Macduff - trust or not?
- Macduff is a close friend of Malcolm - Swears no allegiance now
- questions that Macduff left family @ home
- Scotland's in terrible shape
- "I am not treacherous."
- giving up hope.

Malcolm admits great faults - Tests

Lustful

Macduff's Response

→ there's plenty of women

Greedy

→ your virtues outweigh

I have no virtues

→ we are doomed

you're not fit to live let alone be king

Macduff passes test!

Malcolm:

- virgin - not lustful
- not greedy
- 1st lie he ever told

10k men under Siward, English commander

Act 4, sc. 4 (cont)

King Edward - so good -

healing powers + gift  
of prophecy

- promised to bequeath (pass on),  
powers to royal descendants)
- Man graced by God.

Act 4, sc. 3

~~Mac~~ Malcolm:

- King Edward has healing powers + gift of prophecy
- has promised to bequeath (pass on) his powers to ~~next king~~ royal descendants
- King Ed - man graced by God (unlike Macbeth)
